Football related skills

• Students learn to apply various motor skills, including manipulative skills, in a game situation. These skills have been previously taught outside the context of physical education. Now, students learn to use locomotor skills, throwing, catching, and strategies in a game situation.

Cooperation

• Students have previously learned the cooperation is important in physical activity. Furthering this concept, students learn concepts related to working with peers who have different skill levels than themselves. This is all taught within the context of practicing skills with a partner working together to accomplish a specific football related task.
