## **Learning Progressions**

## Throwing

• Throwing is taught throughout K-12 physical education. During the K-2 program the motor skill is introduced and students explore. Beginning in the 3-5 program students begin applying throwing in specific activities. During softball lessons students learn the importance of accuracy and throwing during modified softball games.

## Safety

• The importance of rules is taught beginning in the first physical education lessons. Students learn to follow rules and procedures in all activities. Softball offers an environment in which students must consider and analyze unique safety procedures and rules.
