

Exemptions

FOR HAZARDOUS OCCUPATIONS **PROHIBITED** FOR MINORS

As noted in Chapter 1: Legal Topics and Responsibilities of the Work-Based Learning Manual, some exemptions apply to the hazardous occupations prohibited for minors.

The conditions for an exemption include the following:

EXEMPTION 1 The student learner is enrolled in a course of study and training in a vocational education training program in agriculture under a recognized state or local educational authority or in a substantially similar program conducted by a private school.

EXEMPTION 2 Such student learner is employed under a written agreement which provides:

- that the work of the student learner is incidental to the training
- that such work shall be intermittent, for short periods of time, and under the direct and close supervision of a qualified and experienced person
- that safety instruction shall be given by the school and correlated by the employer with on-the-job training
- that a schedule of organized and progressive work processes to be performed on the job shall have been prepared.

EXEMPTION 3 Each such written agreement shall contain the name of the student learner, and shall be signed by the employer and by a person authorized to represent the educational authority of school.

EXEMPTION 4 Copies of each agreement shall be kept on file by both the employer and either the educational authority or the school pursuant to 29 CFR 570.72(a).
